**Action Items- January 27, 2016 SNFCI Regional Coordinating Council Meeting:**

- 1) **SNC staff** should be sure to incorporate review of WIP assessment assumptions with key partners early in the process.
- 2) **Shawna Legarza and Marva Willey** will follow up with **Tristyn/Mandy** to coordinate webinar or presentation of Phil Bowden's risk assessment tool with the SNFCI Council (and possibly early adopter forests and WIP partners).
- 3) If it is needed for the WIP, **The Nature Conservancy** may be able to provide SNC the GIS data layer/s for private timberlands for northern California, but it would require an upgraded agreement. **Mandy** will meet with the WIP Team to discuss this and let **David Edelson** know if this is the case, and **David** will look into this further.
- 4) **Kerri Timmer** will send **Mandy** the UCLA center for climate change white papers as they are available (four coming in the next four months), so that she can forward them to the SNFCI Council members.
- 5) **SNFCI Council members of the Tree Mortality Task Force** will convene to talk about key messages for the tree mortality task force to ensure consistent talking points among them. **(No lead person was identified for this task.)**
- 6) **SNFCI Council members** will send Mandy their specific, detailed asks for our 2/23 Quarterly Check-In with Region 5. (This meeting has been postponed to May 23, but this task has been completed.)
- 7) **Tristyn** will schedule a call with the SNFCI Council Policy Group in the next two weeks to identify the asks for 2/23 (by 2/12). (Due to the postponement of this meeting to May 23, this scheduling has been delayed. Tristyn will be following up on this shortly.)
- 8) **Mandy** will add Jerry Bird, Kerri Timmer and Genny Wilson to the Policy Committee List (and remove Chris Nota)
- 9) **Mandy** will send the local contracting workgroup a request to answer the questions discussed during the meeting.
